

**NTR SCORER EDUCATION REQUIREMENT**  
**FOR ALL PROVISIONAL AND REGIONAL OFFICIALS**

All Provisional and Regional referees must complete the Scorer Education Requirement **annually**.

To be **certified** and receive a Scorer **rating**, see **NTR Scorer Advancement and Certification Requirements**.

The Scorer Education Requirement may be satisfied by completion of ONE of the following:

1. In-person attendance at an NTR Officials Division Score Clinic.
2. Register on Webpoint and complete the NT Uniformed Provisional Scorer clinic on-line. Regional referees may choose to complete the NT Uniformed Regional Scorer clinic on-line.
3. Register on Webpoint and take the Form C Scorer Exam for Uniformed Officials and achieve a score of 80% or higher. If a score of at least 80% is not obtained, the Form C Scorer Exam may be re-taken as many times as needed to obtain the required 80% score.
4. Serve as the official scorer for one (1) match (minimum two sets) at an NTR sanctioned tournament and receive a passing rating. Submit the completed rating sheet along with the original scoresheet to the VP of Junior Training or the NTR office. Eligible raters include any current National Scorer, National Referee, Junior National Referee, or North Texas Region Scorer Clinician. The eligible rater may be the assigned R1 or R2 for the rating match.
